Dear Parents, Carers and Community Members,

Our Visual Arts Centre is really beginning to take shape. The area is now fully enclosed with proper walls, windows, doors, locks and Winterfold logos. Next week the entire area will receive a new roof. Shortly afterwards a third of the front of the old canteen will be removed to allow students to flow from the old canteen to the new area during visual arts lessons. This stage was quite complex and involved us engaging the services of a structural engineer to advise on the best way to undertake the job.

As a part of this process the brick paving in the new area will be levelled. Then the entire area will receive a fresh coat of paint as well as some new fluorescent lighting. Eventually we will replace the old oven and that will mean the area can be used as a cooking resource as well.

Thanks to our fantastic P&C and all their fund raising endeavours - very well supported by the school community - the P&C recently contributed \$7000 towards this project which is approximately half. The school did not have the funds to commit the full amount to this project so we are very grateful for the amazing work of our P&C and parent community.

May we encourage parents to continue to contribute to the We Love Art fundraising program so that we may deck out the new visual arts centre with appropriate furniture and resources.

Whilst on the subject of fundraising, what a stunning performance by our students both in terms of their long-distance running ability and their fundraising ability. This event raised over \$4000 which is amazing support for our school. Congratulations to the P&C and specifically to Elanor Rokich, Aidan and Ethan's Mum, who was the coordinator of this event.

Bogan Bingo

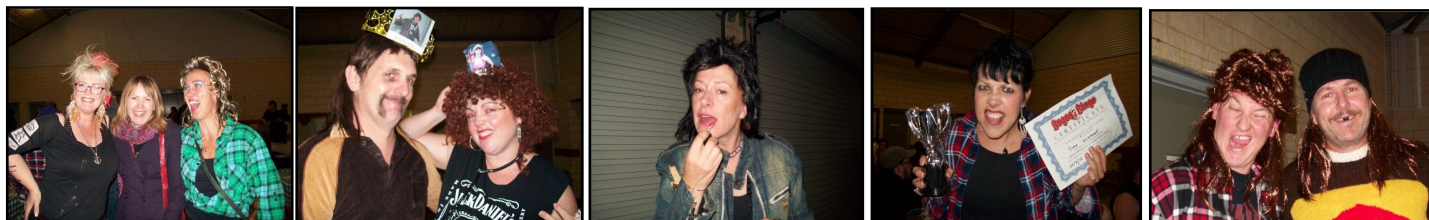
