Dear Parents, Carers and Community Members,

As our community would be aware, our Canteen is the best in WA. Our school, including the Board and P&C, are keen to do our best to support Pip and her team to implement the Department of Education WA - Healthy Food and Drink Policy. The policy states that foods provided by the school must adhere to the Traffic Light system, and, as such, our school has discouraged parents bringing in Birthday Cakes and similar treats. Our thinking around this was to support Pip's endeavours, and also to reduce the potential number of Red Light treats offered to our students. A number of parents have expressed disappointment with this policy, so in an endeavour to find some sensible "middle ground" we are changing this policy a little.

We are very happy to advise that this policy has now been slightly relaxed. Parents are now able to bring birthday treats for distribution to classmates **after the final siren of the day.** This means that school staff will not be distributing the treats and will be adhering to the Policy. We ask that when parents bring these birthday cakes/treats onto the school grounds, they be mindful that we have a number of Anaphylactic students who are allergic to nuts (peanut oil, actual nuts, nutty margarine etc.). Homemade cakes allow the distributor to know exactly what ingredients the cake has and allows informed decisions to be made if parents allow their children to partake. We also ask that parents do not ask staff to distribute on their behalf.

To maintain a focus on healthy eating and since these foods are Red Light, we ask that parents ensure small portions are made. When a teacher is aware that these treats may be offered after school, and an Anaphylactic student is in the room, they will remind that student and also attempt to mention this to the parent with the treats. We asks our parents to be sensitive to the fact that some of our students may need to miss out on treats that other students will enjoy.

We trust that parents appreciate this gesture and support the school in implementing it in the spirit with which it is intended.

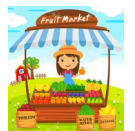
