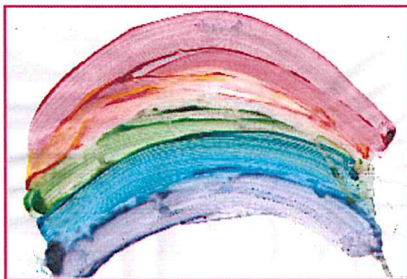

TravelSmart

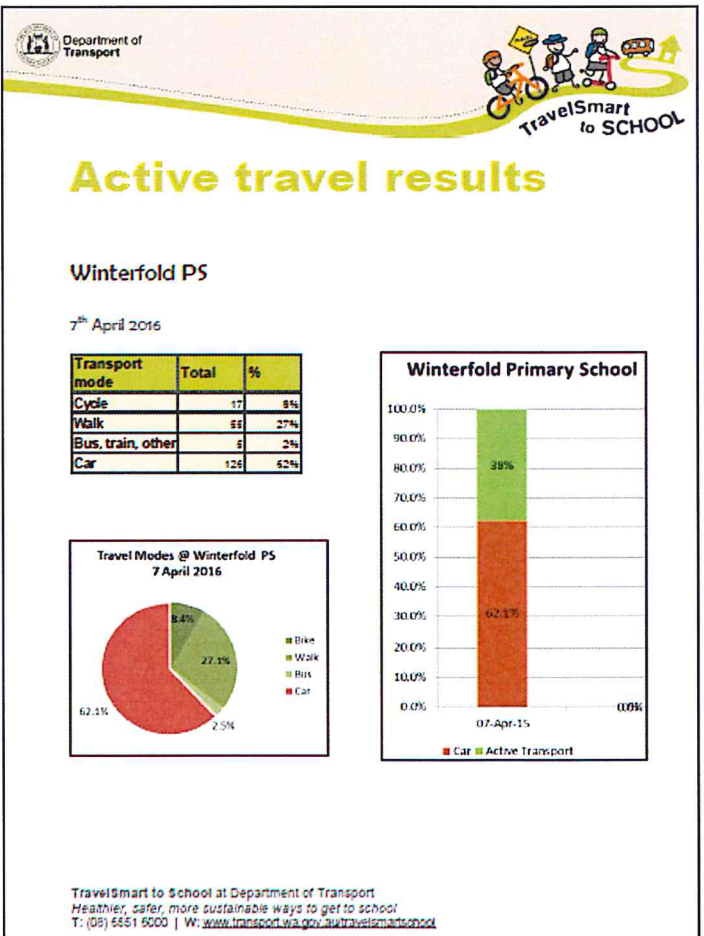
Congratulations to the following winners of our TravelSmart raffles:
